# Sacramento Charter High School Dress Code 2012-13

## Overview

A student's dress and general appearance should not draw undesirable attention to the student, nor should dress and appearance detract or interfere with teaching and the learning environment. It is expected that all students shall maintain their appearance and clothing in a modest, clean, age appropriate fashion consistent with our dress code and compatible with instructional program.

**It is expected that students be in FULL COMPLIANCE with the Sac High dress code. Students not in compliance will be subject to disciplinary consequences.**

## Benefits of School Uniforms

- Positively impacts student achievement
- Establishes a friendly and professional atmosphere that promotes pride, respect and safety
- Instills a sense of community to which students belong
- Increases safety and decreases theft
- Creates level playing field among students
- Helps school officials recognize those who do not belong on campus

## WHAT YOU CAN WEAR

### Shirts and Jackets

ALL STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR SCHOOL ISSUED ATTIRE FROM THE WAIST UP.

Sac High polo shirt (black, white, or purple with Sac High Embroidery)

Shirts must be tucked in and buttoned

Sac High sweatshirts/sweaters

Outdoor jackets/coats (not sweatshirts or sweat jackets) will be allowed to be worn in inclement weather while student is outside. **Jackets are NOT allowed to be worn inside.** Jackets must not be Red, royal blue, maroon, or any florescent colors (hot pink, neon yellow, etc.).

### Pants and Skirts

Solid black, gray, tan or white pants (Dockers Style)

Solid black, gray, tan or white shorts (Dockers Style)

Tights must be solid pattern (nor stripes nor patterns) and be black, white, gray, tan, brown, or purple ONLY.

Solid black, tan, gray or white skirts (no higher than 3 inches above the knee)

### Shoes

Dress or athletic shoes, sandals or socks that do NOT display any red, royal blue, maroon, or any florescent colors (hot pink, neon yellow, etc.) Shoes MUST have back strap

## WHAT YOU CANNOT WEAR

### Shirts and Jackets

Non Sac High approved shirts, sweatshirts, sweat jackets or sweaters

### Pants and Skirts

Jeans/ Denim of any color

Sagging or oversized pants and shorts

Skirts with slits

Short shorts or short skirts

Cargo pants or sweatpants

Stretch pants, shorts, skirts or leggings

### Shoes

Flip flops, moccasins or shoes without a back strap

Shoes or sandals with heels over 2 inches

### Accessories and Other Items

Absolutely **NO RED, ROYAL BLUE, BURGANDY, OR FLORESCENT (HOT PINK, NEON YELLOW, ETC.)** items, clothing, backpacks, purses, scarves, jewelry, etc  
Hats, hoods or caps anywhere on campus

Bandanas, hair scarves, hair nets, curlers, sweatbands or wave caps

Grills

Gang related symbols, insignias, or other gang related apparel

PE clothes (except during PE)

### Hair

Dying, bleaching, adding to (extensions), or tinting hair to an unnatural color or having severely contrasting colors is not permitted. Extreme hairstyles are not permitted.

Note: Dress that compromises student modesty, interferes with learning or is otherwise inappropriate is not acceptable. This includes, but is not limited to overly short or tight clothing, ripped outfits or outfits with holes and clothing that exposes bare midriiffs and backs.
